



WEBSITE TERMS OF USE AND PRIVACY POLICY

The sli.co.in website is owned and operated by the National Rifle Association of India ("NRAI", "we", "us", and "our").

NRAI is the national sports federation, recognized by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, for the sport of shooting in India. NRAI, with the intention of further promoting the sport, has set up a new venture i.e., a franchise-based shooting competition proposed to be called the 'Shooting League of India' ("League").

In order to provide a streamlined source for providing general event information, updates, listings, players profiles, media details, auction details, franchise details, gallery and fixtures for the League (collectively the "Services"), we have made this Website (defined below). We may update, change, or enhance these features from time to time to improve your experience.

By accessing, downloading, using, or registering on our website at sli.co.in (the "Website") from any computer, computer device, mobile, smartphone or any electronic device, you agree to be governed by these Website Terms of Use ("Terms") and the Privacy Policy (defined and detailed below). If you disagree with any part of the Terms and/or Privacy Policy, you may not access the Website.

Use of the Website/Services is subject to these Terms and/or Privacy Policy and additional terms may apply to specific services.

TERMS OF USE

1. Eligibility:

1.1. These Terms & Privacy Policy are a binding contract between you and the NRAI. You must read and agree to these Terms & Privacy Policy before using the Services and the Website.
